- Plant Vendor** — offers plants or flowers that are potted, rooted, or cut; no more than 25% of products offered are vegetables, fruits, meats, fish, dairy, or other products; and the farm is in Tennessee or within 100 miles of Wilson County; TN Dept. of Agriculture Certification.
- Food artisan** — sells applicant's own hand-made, food products made or prepared off site but in Wilson County.
- Arts & Crafts:** handcrafted items created by a craftsperson

Indemnify and hold harmless the City, the Mt. Juliet Farmer's Market, its officers, agents, and employees from:

- Any claims, damages, costs and attorney fees for injuries or damages arising, in part or in whole, from the negligent or intentional acts or omissions of User, its officers, employees, and/or agents, including its sub or independent contractors, in connection with the performance of the Agreement.
- Any claims, damages, costs and attorney fees arising from any failure of User, its officers, employees, and/or agents, including its sub or independent contractors, to observe applicable law, including, but not limited to, labor laws and minimum wage laws.
- User shall pay City any expenses incurred as a result of User's failure to fulfill any obligation in a professional and timely manner under the Agreement.
- Subject to a background check, cost will be paid by vendor.

I understand that I am responsible for my own general and product liability insurance.

In the event that I fail to indemnify and hold harmless as herein agreed, the Mt. Juliet Farmers' Market shall have full rights to defend, pay, or settle said claim on its behalf without notice to me and with full rights to recourse against me for all fees, costs, expenses, and payments made or agreed to be paid to discharge said claim.

In the event of default, I further agree to pay all reasonable legal fees and expenses necessary to enforce this agreement.

This agreement shall be unlimited as to amount and duration.
